Support for COVID-19 Research - NIH Common Fund received \$30 million for the CARES Act 2020 to respond to coronavirus domestically & internationally. The Office of Strategic Coordination (OSC), which manages the Common Fund, issued an immediate funding opportunity in Fiscal Year 2020 for active Common Fund researchers to conduct SARS-CoV-2 and COVID-19 research. <u>OSC is planning new funding</u> opportunities to support new research projects in these areas beginning in Fiscal Year 2021.
